BERLINER PHILHARMONIKER - SARABANDE



The critically acclaimed Berliner Philharmoniker, originally founded in 1882 is made up of 128 world class musicians. Lead by its principal conductor Sir Simon Rattle, the Berliner Philharmoniker is often found on the Europe's Top 5 orchestras list. Here they accompany German concert violinist Anne Sophie Mutter with a rendition of Bach's 'Sarabande'.

GIDON KREMER 'OBLIVION'



Latvian violinist and conductor Gidon Kremer has a distinguished career in music appearing on virtually every major concert stage with the most celebrated orchestras of Europe and America. Gidon Kremer's repertoire is unusually extensive, encompassing all of the standard classical and romantic violin works, as well as music by twentieth century masters. In this video he performs his interpretation of Astor Piazzollo's tango 'Oblivion'.

Born into a musical family, she grew up listening to Brazilian classical musicians like Heitor Villa-Lobos and Ernesto Nazaré. This beautiful song is called 'Grains de beauté' from her 2009 album 'Vagarosa'.

HAYLEY WESTENRA 'THE WATER IS WIDE'



New Zealand soprano Hayley Westenra has established herself as an international star with her debut album 'Pure' now classified as 12 x Platinum in her home country. Known and loved for her highly expressive voice, Hayley sings in several languages including Italian, German, Japanese and Māori. John Rutter is a British composer, conductor, editor and producer most known for his choral works.
