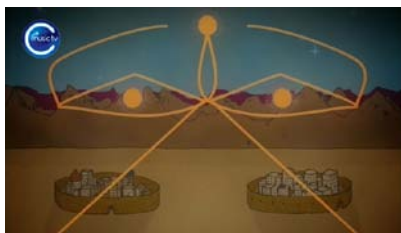
### HARRY POTTER & THE DEATHLY HALLOWS

Italian tenor Vittorio Grigolo was born in Arezzo, Tuscany 1977 & raised in Rome. He discovered a passion for music at a very early age & became a soloist at the Sistine Chapel Choir. His singing talents have seen him performing alongside opera legends Luciano Pavarotti at the age of 13 when he performed in Tosca and later with Spanish tenor Placido Domingo.

Vittorio has shown himself to be extremely versatile singing musical theatre, crossover and more traditional opera pieces. He has played leading roles in Opera houses across the world and continues to delight audience with his rich tone and dramatic performances.
