KYUNG-WHA CHUNG 'SUMMER - THE FOUR SEASONS'



A pioneer in the Asian classical music circuit, Kyung-Wha Chung is a Korean violinist well known for her interpretations of romantic and modern music. In a career spanning three decades, Chung has performed with the world's most prestigious orchestras and conductors, and released a string of hugely successful classical albums, including Vivaldi's well known concerto 'The Four Seasons'.

JULIA THORNTON 'ARIA'



Julia Thornton is one of the UK's leading exponents of the harp and percussion. She has had a diverse and dazzling career that includes performing with orchestras, opera and ballet companies, giving recitals at music festivals, appearing with the medieval group 'Arcana Mundi' and touring with Bryan Ferry. Her debut album 'Harpistry' is a collection of classical solo harp recordings which includes J.S. Bach's 'Aria' from The Goldberg Variations.

ENNIO MORRICONE 'ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN'



Directed by Roland Joffé The Mission (1986) is a film following the experiences of Jesuit missionaries in eighteenth century South America, which stars Robert De Niro and Jeremy Irons. The music for the film was composed by Ennio Morricone, which in turn was nominated and won numerous awards, including the Bafta for Best Film Music. The score was also listed at number 23 on the American Film Institutes 100 Years of Film Scores.

CHRIS COCO & SACHA PUTTNAM 'MARESIAS'



Chris Coco is a British radio DJ, producer and musician well known for presenting BBC Radio One's chill out show 'The Blue Room'. In 2007 he began a creative collaboration with British conductor and classical musician Sacha Puttnam. The collaboration culminated in a highly original album of classical music for a new generation of listeners called 'Remasterpiece', featuring 'Maresias'.

TEATRO 'MUSIC OF THE NIGHT'



Described as *Theatreland's First Supergroup*, Teatro is a quartet of singers who released their self titled debut album in November 2007. The album, which was recorded with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, is a collection of songs from musical theatre, including 'Music of the Night' from Andrew Lloyd Webber's 'The Phantom of the Opera'.

C MUSIC TV CLOSE UP - SCALA 'MAKING OF THE VIDEO'



Formed by Stijn and Steven Kolacny, Scala are a 60 strong all girls choir from Belgium who have quickly gained a reputation as one of Europe's leading contemporary vocal ensembles. Well known for the unique style, Scala have released a number of internationally successful albums featuring classical arrangements of well known pop songs including U2's 'With or Without You' and Kylie's smash hit 'Can't Get You Out Of My Head'.
