



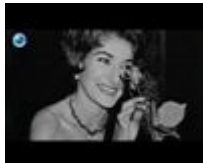

12 CELLISTS OF THE BERLIN PHILHARMONIC - FUGA Y MISTERIO



The 12 Cellists of the Berlin Philharmonic are an all-cello ensemble who came together in 1974 at the Salzburg Mozarteum. Their remarkable sound & tonal combinations are no more apparent than in South American Getaway, a collection of South American inspired music which includes 'Fuga y Misterio' by Argentinean tango composer Astor Piazzolla.

MARIA CALLAS - VISSI D'ARTE FROM THE OPERA TOSCA



Maria Callas was an American-born Greek soprano & perhaps the best-known opera singer of our time. A controversial figure due to her romantic involvement with Aristotle Onassis, Callas was an extremely versatile singer with a repertoire that ranged from classical opera seria to Bel Canto. Puccini's opera Tosca, featuring Vissi d'arte was the last opera she performed.

POWDER BLUE 'THE WOMAN IS THE WAY'



Powder Blue (2009) is a film by Vietnamese-born American screenwriter & director Timothy Linh Bui. Actors Jessica Biel, Forest Whitaker, Eddie Redmayne & Ray Liotta star as four Los Angelenos whose paths cross via chance, tragedy & divine intervention on Christmas Eve. American actor & lead singer of band The Sleeping Masses wrote and performed the title track to the film.

SIGUR ROS 'SVEFN-G-ENGLAR'



Sigur Rós is an Icelandic post-rock band with melodic, classical & minimalist elements. The band is best known for its ethereal & emotionally compelling sound, not to mention lead singer Jónsi's falsetto voice. At last reaching a mass audience, music by the band has appeared Cameron Crowe's 'Vanilla Sky', The Girl in the Cafe & Gregg Araki's film 'Mysterious Skin'. More recently Sigur Ros supported British rock band Radiohead in concert.

NORAH JONES 'COME AWAY WITH ME'



Norah Jones is an American singer-songwriter, pianist, keyboardist, guitarist & actress. With her contemporary jazz sound & sultry voice, Norah rose to fame with her 2002 debut album 'Come Away with Me'. The album sold 25 million copies worldwide & received five Grammy Awards. Her second album, 'Feels like Home', was released in 2004 followed by her 2007 third album, 'Not Too Late'.
